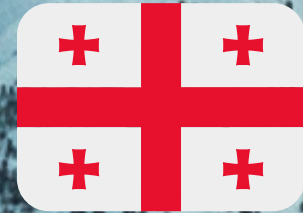

OVERVIEW

Re:Sound is a Youth Exchange that will involve 35 participants from 7 different countries:

Italy, Austria, Hungary, Greece, Georgia, Poland and Croatia.

The project will be held in the Castle Forchtenstein - Europahaus - Neumarkt in der Steiermark, Austria, from the **12 to the 18 May 2019**

Re:Sound is a project about music and body expression. Through different workshops and activities the participants will discover new approaches to **personal and interpersonal musicality, sounds and movement**. The youth exchange will be structured according to different topics such as exploring and connecting with each other, the group(s), community, oneself and with nature





THE METHODS

Re:Sound will involve participants in workshops, activities, reflections and evaluations organized through non formal methods, learning by doing and direct experiences. There will be space where everyone is free to share their feelings and experience **while being supported by and supportive for the others.** The coordinators will facilitate intercultural learning and will support personal processes.
