## EYFON meets FRIDA and "European Bee-Day" 30.05.2022 - 03.06.2022 | Austria, Greece, Slovenia, Sweden

EYFON started the 2022 season with EYFON meets FRIDA. 17 students and 6 teachers from Greece, Sweden, Slovenia and Austria spent some eventful days at the Europaburg in Neumarkt. The project was characterized by sustainability, youth goals and bees and is to be continued with other partners in the coming years.

Pupils from the Fridagymnasiet Mölnlycke, the IT-HTL Ybbs and the Anton Martin Slomšek high school in Maribor experienced the habitat of bees as part of a "European Bee Day" and got to know the "Holzwelt Murau" and sustainable projects in the region. Wild and honey bees are an important part of a functioning environment and a flourishing agriculture. The production of honey is largely sustainable in Europe and contributes to a sensible circular economy in the sense of the Green Deal. The young people were prepared in advance for the EU regulations and projects and learned from practical examples in the Zirbitzkogel - Grebenzen nature park how the implementation of environmental goals can be achieved. In the "Naturlesemuseum Neumarkt", the pupils were able to get to know the distribution of roles in the bee colony as well as the biology and way of life of the bees using a show beehive. With self-made "flower bombs" the young people made their own contribution to the preservation of the habitat of wild bees. The afternoon was dedicated to a visit to the organic beekeeping business of the Maier family in Mühlen, which looks after around 70 bee colonies. Everyday work of a beekeeper, honey production and sustainable marketing were also topics before the students were allowed to extract honey themselves and tasted the differences between blossom and forest honey at a tasting.

Together with the "Panthersie for Europe" team, the young people designed postcards on the subject of sustainability and various "My message for Europe" podcasts. The specialist program was rounded off with discussions on the subject of "My future in Europe" with Claudia Weyringer from the EYFON team. The highlight of the leisure program was the soapbox e-mobility challenge at the end of the week, in which the participants demonstrated a great deal of creativity and skills.

## EYFON | Styrian Partner Region Days "SPRD" 20.06.2022 - 24.06.2022 | Western Balkans

18 students from Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Serbia accepted our invitation to take part in the Styrian Partner Region Days at the end of June. The call for participants took place via the contacts of Land Steiermark to the respective partner regions in the Western Balkans and via the network of the Austrian Chamber of Commerce in these countries.

A varied program of specialist lectures, discussions, workshops and leisure activities inspired the young Europeans. In addition to EYFON Managing Director Christian Buchmann, who gave an overview of Conference on the Future of Europe, and Claudia Weyringer, who discussed with the students the future development of the EU and the opportunities that an expansion to include the Western Balkan countries could offer, one of the participants also organized a workshop on the subject of political responsibility.

Raft building at the Furtner Teich and 3D archery at the Zirbitzkogel, a hike through the Gragger Gorge and in particular the traditional midsummer bonfire at the Buschenschank Zeischgl in St. Marein near Neumarkt provided a lot of entertainment and unforgettable moments for the young people.

#### EYFON | Young Perspectives on the Future of Europe 30.06.2022 - 01.07.2022 | Special event on the occasion of the French Presidency | Vienna

In cooperation with the French Embassy and the House of the European Union in Vienna, EYFON organized a special format this year on the occasion of the French Council Presidency in the first half of 2022, in which youth issues in Europe were one of the main priorities. In addition, one of France's central concerns was to build on the conclusions of the Conference on the Future of Europe and to shape the European Union in a way that is close to the people and fit for the future.

In the premisses of the French Embassy, 22 students and teachers from the Bundesgymnasium Lichtenfels Graz discussed together with H.E. Ambassador Gilles Pécout on their perspectives on the future of Europe. The highlight was the reception and concert that followed, at which the students also got to know the governor of the ÖNB, Robert Holzmann, and ambassador Martin Selmayr, representative of the EU Commission in Austria.

In the House of the European Union, Frank Piplat, Head of the Liaison Office of the European Parliament in Austria, together with EYFON Managing Director Christian Buchmann, Head of the Bundesrat delegation in the Conference of European Parliamentary Committees (COSAC), gave the young people an insight into the progress of the Conference on the Future of Europe the following morning.











## EYFON | Peace Seminar and Ukraine-Day "Nice to meet you" 04.07.2022 - 08.07.2022 | Italy, Georgia, Latvia, Poland, Ukraine

Solidarity, intercultural understanding and, above all, peace in freedom characterize this year's dense program of events at the European Youth Forum in Neumarkt. As part of the first "EYFON | Peace Seminar EU – Ukraine" this year, where 26 young people from Ukraine, Italy, Latvia, Poland and Georgia discussed their future in Europe, peace, their personal freedom, but also propaganda and fake news, we opened the Europaburg castle on 5th July for everyone who wanted to show their support for Ukraine and the Ukrainian refugees who have found shelter in Neumarkt and surroundings. Numerous people from Neumarkt accepted the invitation and got to know typical regional songs and dishes on this atmospheric afternoon, which was organized together with the community of Neumarkt. A delegation from the West Ukrainian University in Ternopil, headed by Rector Prof. Andriy Krysovatyy and Vice Rector for International Relations, Prof. Oksana Desyatnyuk, signed a cooperation agreement with EYFON and the market town of Neumarkt for even closer cooperation between the organizations involved.

During the seminar week, in addition to lectures, discussions and workshops on the subject of peace, the participants experienced many leisure activities in the region in cooperation with teamgeist and the Murau ambassadors: raft building, archery, tape art and an intercultural evening where the young Europeans presented their country to the other seminar participants, provided variety and strengthened the cohesion of the group.

#### EYFON | VIG YouthDays 2022

01.08.2022 - 05.08.2022 | Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Georgia, Kosovo, Latvia, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Ukraine

In the first week of August, everything revolved around the VIG YouthDays at the Europaburg in Neumarkt for the third time: 20 young people between the ages of 14 and 17 from 9 countries spent an exciting and varied time. What all young adults have in common is that at least one parent works for the VIG insurance group.

The initiator of the VIG YouthDays is the Wiener Städtische Versicherungsverein, the main shareholder of the Vienna Insurance Group (VIG): "In cooperation with EYFON, we bring values such as diversity, intercultural understanding and moral courage closer to young adults. Right now it's important to focus on what we have in common. We believe in working together, especially when it comes to children and young people. Because they are our – and Europe's – future," explains Mag. Robert Lasshofer, CEO of Wiener Städtische Versicherungsverein.

Among other things, the young participants created their own podcasts on the topic "My Message for Peace", discussed their ideas for a peaceful future in Europe worth living in and learned a lot about European solidarity and mobility programs. "Bridge building" at the Domino Rally, archery, geocaching and - the highlight for many - a visit to the Red Bull Ring in Spielberg followed by a go-kart race rounded off the exciting week. In order to get hold of one of the coveted places at the Europaburg, originality of the potential participants was required in advance: The young adults convinced with elaborately designed videos, collages, poems and essays on the topic "What Peace means to me". From 200 submissions, the creators of the best and most creative contributions were invited to the varied program of workshops, lectures, discussions and leisure activities.





EYFON | European Peace Event und Season Closing Event 10.10.2022 - 14.10.2022 | Albania, Austria, Bulgaria, Georgia, Greece, Montenegro, Poland, Ukraine

A successful season for the European Youth Forum Neumarkt came to an end on October 14th with an atmospheric chestnut festival in the courtyard of Europaburg Neumarkt. Prior to this, 35 pupils and students from Albania, Bulgaria, Georgia, Greece, Montenegro, Austria, Poland and Ukraine had spent a week discussing their ideas and thoughts on peace and freedom in Europe as part of a "European Peace Event". The result - a "Declaration of Peace" - was presented to the guests by the young Europeans:

We, the young people from many European countries, gathered working and celebrating at the Europaburg Neumarkt in Styria for a peace seminar, want to deliver one single message: Give peace a chance!

War causes death, suffering, destruction, displacement, pain. Why can't we live together in peace, so that young people in particular have a chance to develop their talents and lead a life according to their specific ideas? A life in a world worth living!

We call on all those persons responsible to commit themselves to returning to dialogue. To sit down together, to talk to each other, to find appropriate solutions. You owe this to the young people of Europe and the world.

We young Europeans ask you: Start working for peace in Europe!

During the seminar week it became clear how personal experiences, but also cultural and historical backgrounds of the individual young people shape the opinion about the current war events. Due to the individual concern of the Ukrainian participants, many discussions were also held with strong emotions, but without losing sight of peaceful coexistence, mutual respect and a common wish - peace in freedom.

Univ.-Prof. Dr. Ewald Nowotny, former governor of the Austrian National Bank and President of the Austrian Society for European Policy, clearly stated in his keynote speech: "What we need is a strong Euro and a strong Europe!"

And as one of the participants of the Peace Event appropriately added: "And a strong youth!"



EYFON President Christoph Leitl and Managing Director Christian Buchmann thanked the guests, friends, partners and sponsors of EYFON for their support and their very important investment in the future of Europe - our youth! They will work to ensure that this declaration is heard by the right people and have already sent it to the participants at the G20 summit in Indonesia.





#### **EYFON Foundation**
